



Directions to the OWMP:

Take Highway 10 from the Coachella Valley east to the exit for Desert enter and follow it to the Power Line Road. Go north on the Power Line Road to the posted signs for Sunflower Wash to OWMP Route 1.



Hours of Operation:

Daily sunrise to sunset year round.

Safety Considerations:

Please bring plenty of water and remember to stay on OWMP Route 1.

Season Considerations:

Extreme heat from mid-July to late September. Risk of flooding of roads from October –January.

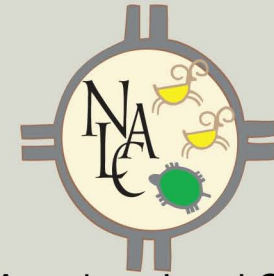
